1. Summary of application

On 26 June 2018, Council received your application, on behalf of Newcastle East Residents Group Inc., under the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009* (**GIPA Act**) in which you sought the following information:

Specific detail of the function hosted by the Lord Mayor of Newcastle, Nuatali Nelmes, at Fort Scratchley on 25 November 2017 as per attached page/file.

1. *For this request, Records has the same meaning as in the GIPA Act.*
2. *Records relating to the function hosted by the Lord Mayor of Newcastle, Nuatali Nelmes, at Fort Scratchley on 25 November 2017 (**the Function**), including documents that disclose:*
 - (a) *the purpose for the Function;*
 - (b) *the names of all persons who were invited to the Function and the dates that those persons were issued invitations to the Function including those issued by the Lord Mayor by email and verbally;*
 - (c) *the relationship between the persons issued invitations to the Function and the purpose for the Function;*
 - (d) *the names of persons who accepted invitations to attend the Function and the dates they accepted such invitations;*
 - (e) *the names of all persons who attended the Function;*
 - (f) *the number of tickets for the Function provided to persons associated with the V8 Supercars event hosted in Newcastle between 24 and 26 November 2017 (inclusive);*

- (g) *the cost of the Function and any payment made by the Newcastle City Council for expenses related to the Function*
- (h) *the spreadsheet referred to in the email sent at 11:30 am, 16th November 2017 by Matthew Murray to Ngaire Baker and Diane Adams, copied to Jeremy Bath, which contains "...a record of the ticket numbers next to the names and express post numbers where necessary"; and*
- (i) *the most recent version of the spreadsheet referred to above.*

On 4 July 2018, you were advised clarification was required and point (f) of your application was amended as follows:

- (f) *the number of tickets for the Function provided to persons associated with the V8 Supercars event hosted in Newcastle between 24 and 26 November 2017 (inclusive) who were invited/given tickets to the VIP event including, but not limited to, DNSW representatives, Supercars representatives and affiliated company representatives, racing team representatives, Ministers, and CAMS representatives.*

2. Decision

I am authorised by the Chief Executive Officer (**CEO**), for the purposes of section 9(3) of the GIPA Act, to decide your access application.

I have decided, under section 58(1)(a) of the GIPA Act, to provide most of the information sought. I have also decided under section 58(1)(d) of the GIPA Act, to refuse access to limited information sought in your application because there is an overriding public interest against its disclosure.

In this Notice of Decision I will explain my reasons. To meet the requirements of section 61 of the GIPA Act, I need to tell you:

- (a) the reasons for my decision and the findings on any important questions of fact underlying those reasons; and
- (b) the general nature and format of the records containing the information you asked for, with reference to the relevant public interest considerations against disclosure (see the attached Schedule of Documents).

You can ask for a review of this decision. For details about how to do so, see part 8 of this Notice.

3. Searches for information

Under the GIPA Act, Council must conduct reasonable searches for the Council information you asked for in your application. Searches were undertaken by the most relevant persons in Council, namely Mr Jeremy Bath (CEO), Ms Ngaire Baker (Executive Officer to the CEO), Lord Mayor, Cr Nuatali Nelmes and Mr Matt Murray (Policy Officer). The following advice was received regarding the searches conducted:

Jeremy Bath

- Search of email "jbath@ncc.nsw.gov.au" under "Supercars + luncheon", "Supercars + function" and "Supercars + VIP".

Ngaire Baker

- Search email only as established a folder at the commencement of the event "Fort Scratchey VIP Supercars Event" and all correspondence was filed in this folder and no letters or documents were done via external mail.

Lord Mayor, Cr Nuatali Nelmes

- Search email "nnelmes@ncc.nsw.gov.au" under "Supercars + luncheon", "Supercars + function", "Supercars + tickets", and "Got your back Sista" for date range 16/10/2017 to 30/11/2017.

Matt Murray

- Search email accounts for "Supercars", "Got your back Sista", "Luncheon", "Supercars VIP function" between 16/10/2017 to 25/11/2017.

I am satisfied that reasonable searches were undertaken and all information identified is listed in the Schedule of documents.

4. The public interest test

Under section 9(1) of the GIPA Act, you have a legally enforceable right to access the information you asked for, unless there is an overriding public interest against its disclosure.

Further, under section 5 of the GIPA Act, there is a presumption in favour of disclosing government information unless there is an overriding public interest against its disclosure.

To decide whether or not there is an overriding public interest against disclosure of the information you asked for, I applied the public interest test, which is set out in section 13 of the GIPA Act.

I applied the public interest test by:

- (a) identifying any public interest considerations in favour of disclosure;
- (b) identifying any relevant public interest considerations against disclosure; and
- (c) deciding where the balance between them lies.

I did this in the way required by section 15 of the GIPA Act, which is:

- (a) in a way that promotes the objects of the GIPA Act;
- (b) with regard to any relevant guidelines issued by the Information Commissioner;
- (c) without taking into account the fact that disclosure of information may cause embarrassment to, or a loss of confidence in, the Government (as that fact is irrelevant);
- (d) without taking into account the fact that disclosure of information might be misinterpreted or misunderstood by any person (as that fact is irrelevant); and
- (e) with regard to the fact that disclosure cannot be made subject to any conditions on the use or disclosure of information.

4.1 Public interest considerations in favour of disclosure

Under section 12(1) of the GIPA Act, there is a general public interest in favour of disclosing government information. However, I am not limited to those considerations in deciding your application. I find the following considerations in favour of disclosure are relevant to your application:

- disclosure of the information could reasonably be expected to promote open discussion of public affairs regarding the function.
- disclosure of the information could reasonably be expected to enhance Council's accountability by ensuring effective oversight of the expenditure of public funds.

Much weight was given to these considerations in favour of disclosure.

4.2 Personal factors of the application

Under section 55 of the GIPA Act, I can also take into account any personal factors of your application. I note the application was made on behalf of the Newcastle East Residents Group Inc. (NERG) which represents local residents affected by the Supercars event (24-26 November 2017). Much weight was given to this consideration in favour of disclosure.

4.3 Public interest considerations against disclosure

When applying the public interest test, the only public interest considerations against disclosure that can be considered are those in schedule 1 and section 14 of the GIPA Act. To show that they are relevant I must establish that the disclosure of the information *could reasonably be expected to have the effect* outlined in the table.

The words “could reasonably be expected to” should be given their ordinary meaning. This requires a judgment to be made as to whether it is reasonable, as distinct from irrational, absurd or ridiculous, to expect the effect outlined.

I have identified the following considerations against disclosure as being relevant to your application, where *disclosure of the information could reasonably be expected to*:

- prejudice any person’s legitimate business, commercial, professional or financial interests - section 14 Table Clause 4(d). Limited weight was given to the above considerations against disclosure as explained at point 4.5 below.
- reveal an individual’s personal information - section 14 Table Clause 3(a). No weight was given to the above considerations against disclosure as explained at point 4.5 below.

4.4 Consultation

As the information sought in your application includes information of other persons and businesses, Council would ordinarily be required, under section 54 of the GIPA Act, to consult with these third parties before considering whether it is can release their information.

However, in this instance, no consultation was undertaken, as explained at point 4.5 below.

4.5 Balancing the public interest test

I have reviewed the relevant public interest considerations in favour of and against disclosure of the information sought.

Any Information disclosed in response to this application is considered to be released to the world at large, and no conditions can be imposed by Council on its use. Accordingly, Council needs to ensure that information is only disclosed where there is an overriding public interest consideration to do so, in accordance with the GIPA Act.

(A) DISCLOSURE OF BUSINESS INFORMATION - section 14 Table Clause 4(d)

Clause 4(d) of the table at section 14 states:

There is a public interest consideration against disclosure if disclosure of the information could reasonably be expected to prejudice any person’s legitimate business, commercial, professional or financial interests.

In order for clause 4(d) to apply, Council must:

- a. identify the relevant legitimate interest; and
- b. explain how the interest would be prejudiced if the information was disclosed. The meaning of the word prejudice is to “cause detriment or disadvantage”.

One of Council’s legitimate business interests is to bring tourism and economic growth to Newcastle. The Coates Hire Newcastle 500 (**the race**), an event of state significance, was held for the first time in Newcastle from 24-26 November 2017. Council organised a VIP event (**the function**) at Fort Scratchley on 25 November 2017.

Businesses who provided services for the function

Documents 1, 2 and 3 contain detailed information relating to the costs of the function and the businesses who were engaged to provide services (relevant legitimate interest).

While the application was made by NERG, I am of the view that the disclosure of this information could reasonably be expected to promote open discussion among the greater community regarding the function. Such disclosure would also enhance Council’s accountability by ensuring effective oversight of the expenditure of public funds. Much weight was given to these considerations in favour of disclosure.

Consultation would ordinarily be undertaken with the businesses to determine whether the disclosure of their information would prejudice their business, commercial, professional or financial interests. This is because some services may have been negotiated between Council and the businesses and revealing certain details may affect the parties’ negotiating powers in the future (consideration against disclosure).

However I have reviewed the information requested and in this instance, I believe that it is possible to release the overall amount of public fund spent on this function for the provision of services by each business, without prejudicing the businesses or Council in their future commercial dealings. No consultation was undertaken as the detailed information can be deleted from the documents without affecting the overall content. As a result, I afforded limited weight to this consideration against disclosure.

On balance, I consider that the public interest consideration against the disclosure of the some business information outweighs the public interest considerations for its disclosure. Accordingly, some information will be deleted from the documents released.

Businesses who were invited to the function

The majority of documents also includes details of businesses and representatives who were invited to attend the function, as well as those who accepted such invitation.

The information sought in your application is very specific, seeking limited release of business information. While consultation would ordinarily have been undertaken with each business, it was not considered to be practical or necessary in this instance when no prejudice can result from such disclosure. I also understand that some of this information is already public knowledge. Accordingly, no consultation was undertaken and limited or no weight was given to this consideration against disclosure.

Further, I am of the view that such disclosure would enhance Council's accountability regarding the expenditure of public money and promote an open discussion regarding the function by showing which businesses and representatives where invited or accepted the invitation to the function. I have therefore given much weight to these considerations for disclosure.

On balance, I consider that the public interest consideration against the disclosure of the business information does not outweigh the public interest considerations for its disclosure. Accordingly, this information will be released.

(B) DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION - section 14 Table Clause 3(a)

Clause 3(a) of the table at section 14 states:

There is a public interest consideration against disclosure if disclosure of the information could reasonably be expected to have the effect of revealing an individual's personal information.

Clause 4(1) of Schedule 4 of the GIPA Act defines 'personal information' as '*information or an opinion (including information or an opinion forming part of a database and whether or not recorded in a material form) about an individual (whether living or dead) whose identity is apparent or can reasonably be ascertained from the information or opinion*'.

Section 15(b) of the GIPA Act provides that Council must have regard to any relevant guidelines issued by the Information Commissioner when determining whether there is an overriding public interest against disclosure. The Information Commissioner published Guideline 4 - *Personal information as a public interest consideration under the GIPA Act*, which sets out further what is meant by 'personal information' under the GIPA Act.

For this consideration against disclosure to apply, it must satisfy a two steps test:

1. the information identified is '*personal*' under the GIPA Act; and
2. the information would be '*revealed*' if disclosed under this application.

In accordance with the Information Commissioner's Guideline and Clause 4(1) of Schedule 4 of the GIPA Act, I have identified the following personal information:

- names of individuals.

Personal information of individual

Invitations were sent to businesses, agencies, politicians and individuals. These invitations also allowed for guests of these representatives to attend the function. These individuals' identity (names) is unlikely not be known to you, and as a result it would be revealed if disclosed under this GIPA application.

Consultation would ordinarily take place as the information sought is personal information of individuals (consideration against disclosure). However, I have reviewed the information contained in the documents and consider that in the circumstances, such disclosure would not be unreasonable. This is because these individuals were identified as attending a Council event, as guests of representatives of businesses, agencies, politicians and individuals, and that event was funded by public money (consideration for disclosure). I am of the view that limited weight should be given to the consideration against disclosure in this instance.

FINDING

On balance, I consider that the above public interest consideration against disclosure of the personal information (names) does not outweigh the consideration for its disclosure. Accordingly, the names will be released.

Other information not personal information of individuals

In accordance with Clause 4(1) of Schedule 4 of the GIPA Act and the Information Commissioner's Guidelines, the names and other details of Newcastle Council staff contained in the documents are not personal information of these individuals as this information merely shows that these individuals were engaged in the exercise of a public function. Accordingly, this information will be released.

(C) INFORMATION OUTSIDE THE SCOPE OF THE APPLICATION

As you sought specific information, much of the information contained in the documents identified falls outside the scope of your application. Accordingly, this information has been deleted from the documents to be released to you.

5. Form of access

A copy of the information sought will be released, as requested in your application. This decision is reviewable under section 80(i) of the GIPA Act, as discussed in part 8 below.

6. Processing charges

Under subsections 64(1) and (2) of the GIPA Act, Council may require an applicant to pay processing charges for the time spent dealing with an application. In this instance, I determined that a 50% discount applied under section 66 of the GIPA Act (special public benefit). The application fee of \$30 therefore counted as a payment of two hours towards the processing charges. It took a further 11 hours to process this application, instead of the anticipated 15 hours. Accordingly, the total cost is \$165. As you have paid \$195 advance deposit, you are entitled to a refund of \$60, as per the table below:

This decision is reviewable under section 80(j) of the GIPA Act as discussed in part 8 below.

7. Disclosure log

If information is released under a formal access application that would be of interest to other members of the public, Council must record certain details about the application in its disclosure log (under sections 25 and 26 of the GIPA Act).

I note that you **objected** to the information being on the disclosure log, however you sought a discount on the ground of "special public benefit". I believe that the information sought would be of interest to other members of the public. Accordingly, I have decided to record the following details in Council's disclosure log, which is publicly available on its website:

- the date on which your application was decided (that is, the date of this Notice of Decision),
- a description of the information that will be released to you,
- whether that information is or will be available to other members of the public, and
- how it can be accessed.

This decision is reviewable under section 80(m) of the GIPA Act, as discussed in part 8 below.

8. Your rights of review

If you disagree with any of the decisions in this Notice that are reviewable, you may seek a review under Part 5 of the GIPA Act.

You have three review options:

- internal review by another officer of Council, who is no less senior than me,
- external review by the Information Commissioner, or
- external review by the NSW Civil and Administrative Tribunal (NCAT)

Your rights of review are outlined in the **enclosed** brochure by the IPC, entitled 'Your review rights under the GIPA Act'. You will also find some useful information and frequently asked questions on the IPC's website www.ipc.nsw.gov.au.

On reviewing the decision, the Information Commissioner can make recommendations about the decision to the agency.

Note: You cannot ask the Information Commissioner to review a decision that has already been reviewed by the NSW Civil and Administrative Tribunal (NCAT).

3. External review by the NSW Civil and Administrative Tribunal (NCAT)

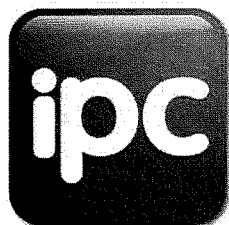
If you disagree with any of the decisions listed above, you can ask for a review by NCAT. You do not have to have the decision reviewed internally, or by the Information Commissioner before applying for review by NCAT.

You have **40 working days** from being notified of the decision to apply to NCAT for review. However, if you have applied for review by the Information Commissioner, you have **20 working days** from being notified of the Information Commission's review outcome to apply to NCAT.

Your review rights under the GIPA Act

Fact sheet

June 2014

The right to information system in NSW aims to foster responsible and representative government that is open, fair and effective.

You have the right to request a review of certain decisions made by government agencies about the release of information under the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009* (GIPA Act):

- a) a decision that an application is not a valid access application
- b) a decision to transfer an access application to another agency, as an agency-initiated transfer
- c) a decision to refuse to deal with an access application (including such a decision that is deemed to have been made)
- d) a decision to provide access or to refuse to provide access to information in response to an access application
- e) a decision that government information is not held by the agency
- f) a decision that information applied for is already available to the applicant
- g) a decision to refuse to confirm or deny that information is held by the agency
- h) a decision to defer the provision of access to information in response to an access application
- i) a decision to provide access to information in a particular way in response to an access application (or a decision not to provide access in the way requested by the applicant)
- j) a decision to impose a processing charge or to require an advance deposit,
- k) a decision to refuse a reduction in a processing charge
- l) a decision to refuse to deal further with an access application because an applicant has failed to pay an advance deposit within the time required for payment
- m) a decision to include information in a disclosure log despite an objection by the authorised objector (or a decision that the authorised objector was not entitled to object).

You generally have three review options.

1. Internal review

You have **20 working days** after the notice of a decision has been posted to you to ask for an internal review by the agency that made the decision.

If a Minister or their personal staff, or the principal officer of an agency made the decision, you cannot ask for an internal review, but you can ask for an external review (see below).

The review must be carried out by an officer who is no less senior than the person who made the original decision. The review decision must be made as if it was a fresh application.

There is a \$40 fee for an internal review application. No fee applies for an internal review if the decision is a 'deemed refusal' because the agency did not process your application in time or the internal review is conducted because the Information Commissioner has recommended the agency reconsider its decision under section 93 of the GIPA Act. In this case, you cannot be charged any review fee.

The agency must acknowledge your application within **five** working days of receiving it. The agency must decide the internal review within **15** working days (this can be extended by **10** working days if the agency has to consult with a third party, or by agreement with you).

2. External review by the Information Commissioner

If you disagree with any of the decisions listed above, you can ask for a review by the Information Commissioner.

If you are the person applying for access to information, you do **not** have to have an internal review of the decision before asking the Information Commissioner to review it.

If you are not the access applicant, you must seek an internal review before applying for review by the Information Commissioner. However, if an internal review cannot be sought (if a Minister or their personal staff, or the principal officer of an agency made the decision), you can seek a review by the Information Commissioner.
