Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009 (NSW) – Notice of Decision: Released in part

Dear Joan Browning,

Summary of access application

I refer to your access application made under the Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009 (NSW), (GIPA Act) which is attached for your reference.

2. Searches for Information

Under the GIPA Act, NSWPF must conduct reasonable searches to locate the government information you seek. A search of NSWPF records has been undertaken to identify all government information falling within the scope of your application. The results of these searches are listed in the Schedule of Documents included in this Notice of Decision.

3. Decision

I am authorised by the New South Wales Commissioner of Police to determine applications made under Section 9(3) of the GIPA Act. I have decided, under s 58(1)(d) of the GIPA Act, to provide access to the information you seek, except where there is an overriding public interest against disclosure.

4. Reason for decision

Under section 9(1) of the GIPA Act, you have a legally enforceable right to access the information you seek, unless there is an overriding public interest against its disclosure.

Under section 13 of the GIPA Act, the Public Interest Test is applied to all applications to identify considerations both in favour of and against disclosure of information to determine where the balance lies between them.

Public Interest considerations in favour of disclosure

In accordance with section 12 of the GIPA Act, I have taken into account the following public interest considerations in favour of disclosure of the information:

- The statutory presumption in favour of the disclosure of government information
- The general right of the public to have access to government information held by the agencies; and
- The information is personal information of the person to whom it is to be disclosed.

Public Interest considerations against disclosure

When applying the public interest test, the only public interest considerations against disclosure that

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I can take into account are those set out in the table to Section 14 and Schedule 1 of the GIPA Act.

Responsible and effective government

Section 14 Table, clause 1(d)

Clause 1(d) of the section 14 Table states that there is a public interest consideration against disclosure if disclosure of the information could reasonably be expected to prejudice the supply to an agency of confidential information that facilitates the effective exercise of that agency's functions (whether in a particular case or generally).

The documents in the Schedule of Documents, refused/redacted under clause 1(d), disclose information that was provided in confidence by the victims. I believe that preserving the confidentiality of such information is integral to the NSWPF maintaining the community's trust in police matters. If that trust is breached, the flow of information to police officers could be jeopardised, which would severely impact this agency's function.

Individual rights, judicial processes and natural justice

Section 14 Table, clause 3(a)

Clause 3(a) of the section 14 Table states that there is a public interest consideration against the disclosure of information that would reveal an individual's personal information.

The documents listed in the Schedule of Documents, that were redacted/refused under clause 3(a), is personal information about other people that could identify them, such as opinion, name, address and date of birth. There is nothing in this agency's records or your application to suggest that you know the information, or that it is in the public domain – ie revealed. Therefore, disclosure would breach the rights of the people concerned to have their information protected.

On balance, I decided that these factors outweigh the section 12 factors and there is an overriding public interest against disclosure of the redacted/withheld information.

I have also considered section 74 of the GIPA Act, which allows an agency to redact (delete) information from a record if the deleted information is irrelevant to the application, or is not within the scope, or an agency has decided to refuse access to the information.

Section 54 - Consultation

There is no evidence within the documents under review to suggest that the persons who tendered information in relation to the incident consented to the disclosure of the information being provided to you. The decision to consult with involved parties, whether consent is provided or not from the applicant, remains the decision of the agency who holds the information, in this case the Police.

Attempts were made to contact the victims mentioned in the incident by telephone to ascertain whether they consent to the release of their personal information and incident version to you. No response was received, and as we were unable to clarify if they do consent to the release of their personal information and incident version, I have no option but to refuse access for the reasons previously explained in this decision.

5. Review rights

If you disagree with any of the decisions in this notice that are reviewable, you may seek a review under Part 5 of the GIPA Act. You have three review options:

• internal review by another officer of this agency,

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- external review by the Information Commission; or
- external review by the NSW Civil and Administrative Tribunal (NCAT).


